

- · Power / "M" Mode button: Turns the action camera on and off. Switches between modes of Camera, Video & Settings

- · Up/ Wi-Fi indicator: Move up in a menu
- · Down button: Move down in a menu
- · Micro SD card slot: Up to 64GB (microSD card not included)
- · Micro USB port: To charge the camera
- · OK/Shutter button: Take a photo/start video recording/stop video recording/ confirm a selection

#### Charging the batteries

- Connect the camera to a computer or use a standard 5V 0.5A wall adaptor with the supplied USB charging cable
- The LED beside the screen will turn red and the battery icon at the top of the screen will display a charging flash icon

NOTE: The camera takes around 4 hours to fully charge

#### Inserting a microSD card

The Action Camera does not have any internal memory. A microSD card (not included) must be inserted for the Action Camera to record footage and capture images

- While the Action Camera is off, insert a microSD card into the port on the side of the Action Camera and push the card all the way into the port. When correctly inserted into the Action Camera, you will feel a small click. Your Action Camera is now ready to record and capture images
- 2. To remove the microSD card, push the card in slightly until you hear a click, the card will then pop out from the Action Camera for removal

#### NOTE:

- Ensure that the microSD card you have inserted has a maximum capacity no more than 64GB and is at least Class 10
- CAUTION: If you are installing a previously used memory card into the camera, make sure to back up any data stored on the card, to avoid possible data loss

#### Waterproof housing

The camera comes supplied with a transparent waterproof housing, which allows you to take video footage or photos in wet conditions or under water at a depth of up to 30 meters

To use the camera with the waterproof housing, observe the following:

- 1. Place the camera in the waterproof housing and close it carefully using the locking clip located at the top of the case. Make sure the latch lock key is securely in place
- Once the camera is securely installed, you can use the power and shutter buttons by pushing the buttons located on top of the waterproof housing

**WARNING:** Once the camera is secured in the case, make sure that all seals are in place to prevent water intrusion.

#### Before using the camera in wet conditions

- Before sealing the case, ensure the rubber seal of the camera housing is clean even a single hair
  or grain of sand can cause a leak. You can test watertightness by closing the case without inserting
  the camera
- Submerge the empty case completely in water for about a minute. Remove the case from the water, dry off its exterior with a towel, then open the case. If the entire interior is dry, the case is safe for use underwater
- 3. After using the camera in saltwater, rinse the outside of the housing with non-saltwater and dry. If not properly cleaned, corrosion can occur on the hinge and the pin, which can cause failure.

**WARNING:** Do not use aggressive substances such as acetone to clean the case, as these can cause permanent damage

4. To clean the seal, rinse in fresh water and shake dry (drying with a cloth may cause lint to compromise the seal). Re-install the seal into the grooves in the back door of the housing

#### Powering on & off

- Power on: Press and hold the power button for about 3 seconds; the screen will start up and the camera will enter standby mode
- Power off: While the camera is in an idle state, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn the camera off
- Automatic power off: When the camera has been idle, it will switch off automatically to save power.The idle time can be set to your preference in the settings menu
- 4. Power off due to low battery: If the camera's battery power has dropped to extremely low levels, the icon will appear on the LCD screen and you will have to recharge the battery. When the icon turns red and flashes, the camera will automatically power off

#### Mode selection

The camera is equipped with five modes: Recording, Photo, Movement, Playback & Settings. Turning on the camera, use the mode button to select the appropriate mode for your intended use

- 1. Video mode (Loop): Record videos
- 2. Photo mode: Take photos
- 3. Movement mode: Record videos of fast or high amounts of movement
- 4. Playback: View and play all recorded video and photos stored on the SD Card
- 5. Settings: Adjust camera settings

#### Video mode


- 1. Press the power button to turn on the camera
- 2. Repeatedly press the power button to go through the different modes available
- 3. Select Video mode
- 4. Press the OK button to start recording a video
- 5. While recording, press the OK button to stop recording (Video recording will stop automatically if there is no space left on the memory card, or if the battery is flat)
- 6. In video mode, the LCD screen will display the following icons
  - a. Mode: Indicates that the current mode is Video. When this symbol is red then the camera is recording
  - b. Video quality: Indicates the quality and frame rate of the recordina
  - c. Storage available: Shows remaining space on the microSD Card
  - d. microSD card: Indicates that a memory card is inserted
  - e. Wi-Fi: Indicates if Wi-Fi is on or off
  - f. Battery: Indicates battery level
  - g. Microphone: Indicates if the microphone is active
  - h. Date and time: Shows the date and time on the device's display

#### Photo mode

- 1. Press the power button to turn on the camera
- 2. Repeatedly press the power button to go through the different modes available
- 3. Select camera mode
- 4. Press the OK button to take a still picture
- 5. In camera mode, the LCD screen will display the following icons:
  - a. Mode: Indicates that the current mode is Camera. The symbol will be red when a photo is taken
  - b. Image resolution: Indicates the current image resolution
  - c. Storage available: Shows remaining space on the microSD Card
  - d. microSD card: Indicates that a memory card is inserted
  - e. Wi-Fi: Indicates if Wi-Fi is on or off
  - f. Battery: Indicates battery level
  - g. Date and time: Shows the date and time on the device's display







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

#### Movement mode

- 1. Press the power button to turn on the camera
- 2. Repeatedly press the power button to go through the different modes available
- 3. Select movement mode
- 4. Press the OK button to start recording a video
- While recording, press the OK button to stop recording (Video recording will stop automatically if there is no space left on the memory card, or if the battery is flat)
- 6. In movement mode, the LCD screen will display the following icons
  - Mode: Indicates that the current mode is Movement. When this symbol is red then the camera
    is recording
  - b. Video quality: Indicates the quality of the recording
  - Storage available: Shows remaining space on the microSD Card
  - microSD card: Indicates that a memory card is inserted
  - e. Wi-Fi: Indicates if Wi-Fi is on or off
  - f. Battery: Indicates battery level
  - g. Microphone: Indicates if the microphone is active
  - Date and time: Shows the date and time on the device's display



#### **Playback**

Enter playback mode to browse your photos and videos, and to play videos recorded by the camera

- 1. Press the power button to turn on the camera
- 2. Repeatedly press the power button to go through the different modes available
- 3. Select playback mode
- 4. You can press the up/down key to select playback option and then press the OK button to enter
- 5. Scroll through the saved videos and photos on your microSD card in playback
- 6. To play a video, press the OK button to start/pause play video
- 7. Press the power button to stop playing the video

#### Setting the date and time

- Press the power button to switch between different modes. You will reach the Settings menus after Playback mode
- Once you arrive at the setting menus, press OK button to enter. Press the Menu button to open a menu, and then press the power button to switch over to the setup menu
- 3. Select Date and Time, and then press the OK button to enter the setup window
- 4. In the setup window, press the OK button to select the item to be adjusted (e.g. date, time). The selected item will be highlighted. Then use the Up/ Down buttons for adjustment
- Press the OK button to confirm your entry, or press the power button to cancel the setup and return to menu

### Action Camera App

To use Wi-Fi function of your action camera, you need to have the necessary app installed in your smartphone

- 1. Search for "XDV" in the Google Play Store (for Android OS) or in the Apple App Store (for iOS) to find the app and install it according to the instructions
- 2. Install the "XDV" app on your smartphone or tablet
- 3. Enter into settings menu and turn on Wi-Fi
- 4. Enable Wi-Fi on your smartphone or tablet and search for the wireless AP signal 'SportsDV', and enter the Wi-Fi password: 12345678
- 5. Click the icon in the app list of the smartphone or tablet to open it. Now you can preview the image sent by the action camera on your phone or tablet and start some operating
- 6. This app shows 3 options in the main display: Video, Photo and Movement
- 7. On the bottom you can also see 3 other options: Main capture display, media library and settings. In 'Settings mode' you will be able to configure the camera settings before recording

### Action Camera Menu

#### Settings menu

To access the settings menu, press the Power/Mode button to toggle through the modes until you reach the Settings menus. When you arrive at the setting menus, press the OK button to enter. You will see Video settings, Photo settings, General settings, System settings and Exit. Use the Up/Down button to scroll up/down; use the OK button to enter or confirm a selection, and use the Power/Mode button to switch between each of these settings menus

# **FAQs**

Question	Solution
I press the OK button to take an image but there is no response	Make sure you have inserted a microSD card into the action camera. Wait for the data process to complete and then take your next photo OR delete some photos / videos from your microSD Card, if the memory is full
Automatically stops when recording. The message "Card Error" appears on the screen when a microSD Card is inserted	Copy and save all footage you want to retain to another device. Then, format your microSD Card using the format option (see Action Camera Settings for details) and try again OR use a high speed microSD Card (minimum class 6). The Action Camera is not compatible with microSD XC cards
Can't take photos or record video	Check if the microSD card has enough space or is locked or format your microSD card
Unclear video footage	Check if there is any dirt or fingerprints on the lens. Use a clean, dry, lint free cloth to clear the camera lens
Black image when recording sky or water scene	Scenes with a lot of contrast may influence the automatic exposure function of camera. Adjust the exposure settings to compensate

- · When the battery is low and flashing red you must charge the Action Camera
- If the battery is completely discharged, the Action Camera cannot be turned on immediately when
  the charger is connected. Allow a depleted battery to charge for a few minutes before turning on the
  Action Camera
- Always try to keep the battery between 15°C and 30°C. A product with a hot or cold battery may not
  work temporarily, even when the battery is fully charged
